Prof. Kerpel-Fronius is a professor of clinical pharmacology at Semmelweis Medical University in Budapest, Hungary. He is actively involved in PharmaTrain and is the leader of Work Package 5: Geographical Extension of Training Sites and Network.

He has held teaching positions at the department of Anatomy of the Semmelweis University, a Fellowship at the Dept. of Pharmacology, Karolinska Institute, Stockholm (1967-68), a Alfred P. Sloan Fellowship in Neurobiology, Maryland University, US (1972-74). He was also Head of Clinical Research at the Hungarian, National Institute of Oncology. He has completed Board Examinations in clinical laboratory sciences (1977) and clinical pharmacology (1980). Prof. Kerpel-Fronius also held positions in the pharmaceutical industry, as head of clinical oncology & CNS research (1989-2001) at Sterling (Europe) and Farmitalia-Pharmacia (Germany). In addition to being a professor of pharmacology, he is Director of the Hungarian National Institute of Pharmacy (i.e. Hungarian Drug Regulatory Agency).
