Prof. Dr Abdul Rahman Mohamed received Ph.D. degree in Chemical Engineering from University of New Hampshire, USA. Since 1993, he has been serving as lecturer in the School of Chemical Engineering at Universiti Sains Malaysia. His research interests span the areas of reaction engineering and catalysis, air pollution, wastewater treatment, fuel technology and nanotechnology. To date, he has obtained more than 80 research grants, amounting to more than RM 23 million. He has supervised more than 40 postgraduate students (Master/PhD). According to Scopus bibliographic database dated 29th July 2016, Prof. Rahman has H-Index of 47 and a total citation of more than 7000. His research has been published in more than 300 peer-reviewed articles in international/national journals. Furthermore, he has established research linkages with Osaka University (Japan), Nagaoka University of Technology (Japan) and University of Lorraine (France). Besides teaching and research, Prof. Rahman contributes significantly to University's administration. Currently, he is the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Industry and Community Network) of Universiti Sains Malaysia.
